

St. Aug's grads give back to community

RALEIGH – Three Saint Augustine's College graduates are giving back to the community in a big way. Ronneil Robinson, Tyrone Green and LaShai McNeal are running a free tutorial program to help students reach their highest potential.

The Give Back Organization, a nonprofit group, was founded in 2002 by Robinson, 28, who graduated from St. Aug's with a degree in computer science.

The GBO is designed to help students (K-12) obtain the skills to maximize their opportunities for an advanced education. The tutors help students in difficult subjects by giving them one-on-one attention.

Since it opened, the center has become quite popular. Fifty students are currently enrolled, and another 100 are on the waiting list. Robinson said more students could be served if the group had more volunteers.

The GBO services include End of Grade test preparation, personal development mentoring, computer learning, campus tours and college application assistance. The organization also prepares high school students for the ACT and
